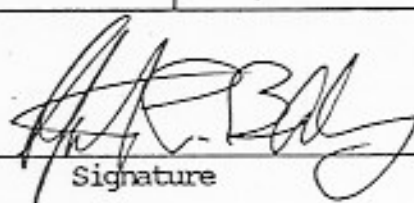

Amendment to Articles of Incorporation
Nonprofit Corporation

PORTLAND WHEELMEN TOURING CLUB, INC.

Article VI:

Distribution of Assets on Dissolution or Final Liquidation:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, all of the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to one or more domestic organizations which has established its exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is then engaged in activities substantially similar to those having been carried on by the corporation or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Article VII:

Other Provisions:

7.1 Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

7.2 This corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers or other private individuals or to organizations organized and operated for a profit.

7.3 No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
