Rides on Dates of Club Meetings and Events Policy Adopted December 2025

Purpose:

The general PBC membership club meeting is an opportunity for all club members to attend and obtain the latest information related to the club and cycling, enjoy presentations related to all aspects of cycling, make comments about the functioning of the club and rides, and socialize. Good attendance representative of the club at large is necessary for the Board to provide guidance in the best interests of the membership, and for members to better understand each other. Attendance should be encouraged and barriers to attending should be eliminated.

The STP, Pioneer Century, Club Picnic, Club Awards Banquet, and New Years Day Ride are all special events that substantially benefit the club and require club members volunteering and/or club members riding to be successful.

Policy:

Club rides shall not conflict with the Club Membership Meeting, STP, Pioneer Century, Club Picnic and associated Club Picnic rides, Club Awards Banquet, and New Years Day Ride. On Club Meeting days and Club Awards Banquet day, rides may occur earlier in the day only if the ride gives members a reasonable amount of time to prepare for and attend the meeting or banquet. On Club Picnic day, rides may occur after the event. Any exceptions shall be approved by the Board.

Road Captains may not post rides that they determine are in conflict with this policy.

Rides on Dates of Club Meetings and Events Policy: approved and adopted at the December 17, 2025 Board Meeting.
